

Who is The Rider on the White Horse?



- He is already victorious
- He is given a **crown** (A victor's crown) Matt 27:29; 2 Tim 4:8; 1 Pet 5:4; Rev 2:10; 3:11; 4:4, 10; 12:1; Rev 14:14
- He is riding a white horse Rev 1:14; 2:17; 3:4, 5, 18; 4:4; 6:2, 11; 7:9, 13-14; 14:14; 19:11, 14; Rev 20:11
- He goes forth conquering to conquer
- O He "returns" in **Chapter 19:11-16**
- What about the "bow"?

Fifth Seal: Souls Under the Altar

Revelation 6:9-11



Who are these Souls Under the Altar?

- Slain for the testimony of God – vs. 9
- Told to wait for the martyrdom of their fellow servants – vs. 12
- This is a key symbol to understanding the purpose of the Revelation.
- The avenging of the apostles and prophets (Revelation 18:20; 19:2)
- READ Luke 11:45-64





Cosmic Chaos or "De-Creation"

- O Isaiah 13:9-10 Against Babylon
- Ezekiel 32:7-8 Against Pharoah of Egypt
- Joel 2:30-31 Against Jerusalem (586 BC)
- O Haggai 2:21-22 Against Gentile Kingdoms
- Matthew 24:29 Against Jerusalem (70 AD)

This is **apocalyptic** language employed in Scripture to announce the overturning of nations and governments. It cannot always mean the actual end of heaven and earth because it occurs numerous times in Scripture and in the Revelation.

Revelation 16	The Seven Bowls of Wrath	The entirety of Earth and Sea

Second Seal	Red Horse	Sixth Seal	Moon turned to blood
Third Seal	Black Horse		Sun turned black
Fourth Seal	Green Horse	Seventh Seal	Green Grass Burned
