



## The Second Interlude (9:20 – 11:14)

- The word 'interlude' does not appear in Revelation (or the Bible), but it is used to describe a pause or delay in the sequence of events
  - The First Interlude Follows the Opening of the **Sixth**Seal (7:1-17)
  - Second Interlude Follows the Sounding of the Sixth
    Trumpet (9:20-11:14)

# The Significance of the Signs



- The Seals represent the marshalling of God's covenantal curses for their disobedience
- The Trumpets represent the announcement of God's punishment upon the disobedient Jews
- > The Bowls of Wrath represent the outpouring of God's wrath on apostate Jerusalem
